Lifebound Tours teams up with Canadian University College to offer a unique travel experience. This 17-day tour includes four world-class pyramids, three nights in the Amazon, two gorgeous oceans, and the one-and-only Machu Picchu.

We'll begin with the pre-Aztec site at Teotihuacan near Mexico City. Then we'll fly to Cancun from where we'll tour the Mayan centers of Chichén Itzá, Tulum, and Uxmal. Proceeding by air to Perú we'll spend three nights in a jungle lodge before visiting Cuzco and the lost Inca city of Machu Picchu. En route Dr. Tennyson Samraj of CUC will offer an optional course on the religion of these three cultures.

You'll be able to climb five pyramids, take four Inca trails, swim in three famous bodies of water, walk through two pre-18th Century convents, and paddle your own dugout canoe to an Indian village. All along the way we'll enjoy delicious typical cuisine, while staying in especially well-located accommodations. Visits to local markets and residences will also be included.

The cost of this tour is only \$3350 including air fare, tours, meals, and tips. Bring a friend and receive a \$200 discount. If you wish to receive college credit in Philosophy add \$300 (lecture participation is optional and attendance is free if you are not seeking credit).

Daily Highlights

Day Activity

1 M Fly south to Mexico City and lodge near the Zocolo, the center of Aztec and Mexican civilization.

2 T Bring to life the history and mystery of "the place of the gods" at the impressive pyramids at Teotihuacan.

3 W Explore the Aztec Templo Mayor discovered in 1978, and visit beautiful colonial Coyoacán where Hernán Cortés launched his attack on Tenochitlan, the Aztec capital.

4 T Travel east by air to Cancun on the Caribbean where we'll take in the local flavor at our beachside lodge.

5 F Tour Chichen Itzá with its 1200-year-old El Castillo, its Temple of the Warriors, and its astronomical observatory.

6 S Relax in the Hacienda at Uxmal, visit the impressive Mayan city, explore overgrown, unrestored pyramids, and take in the light and sound show at night.

7 S Cross the peninsula through tropical forests by motorcoach to the seaside Mayan ruins of Tulum before returning to our beachside lodge for a swim.

8 M Fly over Central America to Lima, Perú, city of the kings founded by Francisco Pizarro soon after conquering the Inca empire.

9 T Visit Lima's colonial heart before traversing Perú by air to the southeast jungle outpost of Puerto Maldonado where we'll travel by dugout canoe up the Tambopata River.

10 W Observe spectacular Macaws at the claylick, learn some medicinal plants of the Amazon, and spot monkeys, tapirs, and toads on the trail.

11 T Let the hum of the jungle carry you along muddy trails to hidden lakes and Indian villages before an evening alligator hunt (no killing).

12 F Escape the Amazon for the sacred city of Cuzco with its vivid evidence of three great cultures: the Inca, the Spanish & the Mestizo.

13 S Enjoy a free morning in Cuzco and an afternoon walk around the incredible boulders of Sacsayhuaman, the scenic remains of Tambo Machay, and the stone labyrinths at Qenqo.

14 S Take the early train north, then board a waiting bus for a ride up the switch-backs to the lost city of Machu Picchu with its story and its possible climb up Huayna Picchu.

15 M Walk Inca trails to the Door of the Sun, & the Inca Bridge before descending to our train at Aguas Calientes & the ride back to Cuzco.

16 T Fly to Lima loaded with souvenirs, dirty clothes, and a bit of a sun tan for a visit to well-healed Miraflores and our farewell dinner and show.

17 W Arrive home filled with memories of Mariachi and highland music, white sandy beaches, massive pyramids, scrambling monkeys, and the thrill of scaling Huayna Picchu.
