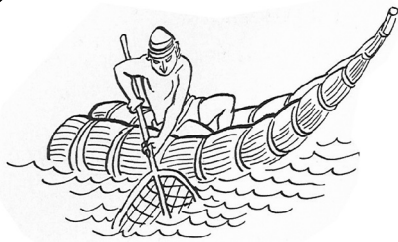


Lifebound Tours



NORTH PERU

Spectacular archeological sites, a wide variety of wildlife, gorgeous mountain scenery, scrumptious food, and cultural immersion all come together on this fully escorted, 17-day *Lifebound Tour*.

The Chimu, Mochica, Chachapoya, and San Martin Indian cultures are all included in our upcoming **North Peru** tour. Sites like the Temple of the Moon, Chan Chan, Sipan, and Küelap will all be visited.

As our small group explores the Chaparri Reserve, Foca Island, Gocta Falls, the Tingana Nature Preserve, and the Huallaga River eco system we will observe Spectacled Bear, condors, White-winged Guan, sea lions, Sechuran Foxes, boobies, giant iguanas, rare humming birds, monkeys, parrots, and maybe an ocelot.

Following Francisco Pizarro's route into the Andes that goes no higher than 6,000 feet above sea level makes this the lowest Andean crossing in Peru and one of the most scenic. Crashing streams, bromeliad-festooned cliffs, verdant jungle, and towering peaks will surround our travel here.

Before entering the Andes we'll explore the fertile Egypt of Peru. These coastal plains are filled with gold-adorned pyramids, ancient adobe cities, Peruvian Paso horses, and marinera dances.

Daily Highlights

Day	Activity
1 T	Fly south over the equator to Lima, Peru's federal capital, the City of Kings.
2 W	Take a brief tour of colonial Lima - its Plaza de Armas, National Cathedral, and Santo Domingo Convent – before our flight to Trujillo.
3 T	Experience Chan Chan's adobe city, Huanchaco's Pacific wave action, dancing Peruvian Paso horses, & Huaca de la Luna.
4 F	Travel north to the Pomac Forest & Chaparri Conservation Area with its white-winged guans, spectacled bear, & Sechuran foxes.
5 S	Relax by the bird feeder, visit the condor & bear restoration areas, and explore by horse or by foot all the things that Chaparri has to offer.

6 S **Visit** the Royal Tombs of Sipan, the Chiclayo witches market, and the Brunning Gold Museum in Lambayeque.

7 M **Sail** out on the Pacific to Foca Island in search of marine mammals, nesting birds, local fishermen and a white sandy beach.

8 T **Tour** the Spaniard's first city of Piura, shop in pottery-rich Chulucanas, & travel east over the Porculla pass which Pizarro used when he conquered the Incas.

9 W **Marvel** at the canyons that cradle the Utcubamba River and its lost civilizations as we walk or ride horseback to Gocta Falls, third highest in the world.

10 T **Ascend** out of the canyons for a visit to festive Luya, archeologically-rich Lamud, & the Sarcophagi of Karajia.

11 F **Climb** into the Chachapoya citadel of Küelap discovering its unique architecture, its beautiful setting, and the secrets of its history.

12 S **Enjoy** a festive day in peaceful Chachapoyas the hub of what once was the empire of the Cloud People.

13 S **Photograph** beautiful Pomacocha Lake, explore Diamante Caverns, & relax at our rustic lodge near Rioja.

14 M **Descend** a jungle river to the Tingana floodplains in search of wild monkeys, canopy birds, and Coati Mundis, before visiting an orchid garden in Moyobamba.

15 T **Experience** the peaceful grounds, the excellent meals, the gregarious Oropendulas, and the forest trails at our remote lodge beside the mighty Huallaga River.

16 W **Savor** the tropical cuisine, cruise the Huallaga, and observe coffee & cocoa production, before returning to Tarapoto & our flight to Lima.

17 T **Return** home loaded with memories from Peru's fertile North Coast, its mountainous cloud country, & its Amazon fringe jungle.
