

Do you truly love me more than these?

John 21:1-25

After reading the book of John it seems that he has some disagreements in some areas with Peter. He remembers that Peter denied Jesus 3 times after Jesus was captured. Here being asked 'do you really love me?' he had to reply three times in shame "Yes Lord, you know that I love you". This conversation strengthened his foundations in his faith and loyalty in Christ. After this counseling, Jesus helped a once weak, broken man stand up on his feet again. I believe that the Bible uses this story to remind us that when we are like Peter, when our faith is weak, and sometimes even stumble and deny His name; we need his voice to redeem us.

1. Peter said; "I am going out to fish", the other disciples followed him also.

If Jesus never rose again and had not been seen by his disciples, it is understandable that they would follow Peter out to fish. However they have already witnessed Jesus' resurrection and received instructions to preach the gospel of peace, yet they still went back to their old occupation. Jesus did not rebuke them nor indicate they did the wrong thing. Jesus shows that no matter what decision we make nor any work we might be doing and He will always be by our side. He also reveals to us that we cannot succeed in anything if we do it by our own strength or experience because in the end, "That night, nothing was achieved and their effort was in vain." If Christians obey Jesus' teachings and "cast (their) net on the right side of the ship" they will experience God's amazing grace and receive a bountiful reward and success.

2. It's the Lord!

Why was it that John was the first to discover it was the Lord Jesus? This was because his relationship to Jesus was more intimate than the others. The disciples heard "cast your net on the right of the ship" and John remembered straight away that 3 years ago there was a night when they didn't catch any fish and the Lord had said, "Put your nets out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch." Peter had reluctantly done as he was told and the net was full of fish. Now 3 years later the same thing happened, John immediately recalling Jesus' words and proclaimed, "It is the Lord!" Our past experience reminds us that God is always with us and that we need to have a sensitive heart to hear His will. We should be like Peter, when being told what to do we should obey him immediately holding nothing back, letting go of our own personal desires. Many times we are like the disciples, Jesus is standing on the shore and speaking to us but we do not hear Him. So sometimes He will allow us to go through hard times and gain nothing. At those times we should be reminded that it might be the Lord speaking to us.

3. Do you truly love me more than these?

The word Love is mentioned 7 times in His conversation with Peter. The "love" Jesus required for Peter may not exactly be the same "love" that Peter knew. Jesus' "love" is unconditional, Godly "love"; however Peter's version of love is limited and conditional. Peter said, "Lord you know all things, you know I love you.' Jesus asked the question, "Do you love me more than all these?" These things could be regarded as his boat, his own profit. Peter responded three times 'You know that I love you.' Jesus required him to re-confirm his loyalty to Him as well as giving him an even bigger responsibility and commission in order to help him regain his confidence. Now Jesus is asking us the same question, "Do you love me more than these things?" More than you work, family, fame, authority, hobbies, comfort. Do you love Jesus more than all these things?

你愛我比這些更深麼?

約翰福音二十一章 1-25 節

約翰好像有意跟彼得過不去,記載他三次不認主,又記載主耶穌問他,"你愛我比這些更深嗎?" 要他三次慚愧 的回答說。"主啊,你知道,我愛你"。這三次的問答,奠定了他信心的基礎和對主的忠心。經過這次的"愛"的輔 導,主耶穌幫助了一個軟弱而跌倒的人,重新站立起來,我相信聖經記載這段經文,要告訴我們,當我們發現 自己跟彼得一樣,信心軟弱的時候,甚至失望,跌倒,否認主的時候,也需要主來呼聲和挽回。

一,彼得說,"我打魚去",其他門徒也跟著去了。

如果主耶穌沒有復活,沒有顯現給門徒看,他們因為失望而作出這樣決定,還可以理解和接受,但是主顯現之 後,他們已經得到主的托付,差遣他們去傳和平的福音。 為什麼他們要重操舊業打魚去呢?主並沒有責備他們, 不說他們對不對,主讓我們看見,無論我們作什麼決定,從事那一行業,主都在我們旁邊。主讓我們知道,僅 僅靠自己的經驗和努力去謀生,結果就是"那一夜也沒打著什麼"。基督徒如果願意照著主的吩咐去作工,聽主的 話,"把網撒在船的右邊",就會經歷主奇妙的恩典,有出呼意料之外的收獲和成就。

二,是主!

為什麼是約翰首先發現是主?因為他與主的關係比較親密,比較靠近,門徒聽主說,"把網撒在右邊",魚多的 拉不上來。他立刻想起三年前也是在一個夜晚,打不到魚,主說"把船開到水深之處下網打魚",彼得勉強照者主 的話去作,不料卻捕滿了魚。三年後,這件事再次發生,約翰馬上想起主的話,立刻說"一定是主"。過去的經歷 提醒了我們,主隨時隨地在我們身邊。我們對主要有一顆敏銳的心,體會主的心意。關心主所說的話。也要像 彼得一樣,一聽到是主,就不顧一切,飛奔要到主的面前,不要只關心自己的利害或安全,收獲的多寡。許多 時候,我們像門徒一樣,主就站在岸邊,我們卻不知道,主對我們說話,我們也聽不到,主只好讓我們遭遇一 點難處,當我們整夜勞累,卻一無所獲的時候,當想一想為什麼?難道主在旁邊提醒我們什麼?

三, 你愛我比這些更深嗎?

主與彼得對話,七次說到"愛"這個字,耶穌問彼得,所用的"愛",與彼得所回答所用的"愛"。兩個字層次不同, 主耶穌所用的"愛"是神聖的愛,毫無保留,完全的愛。而彼得所說的愛是有限的愛,他說"主啊,你是無所不知, 你知道我愛你",但是"我愛你不夠。主耶穌問彼得"你愛我比這些更深嗎?""這些"可能指的是打魚的收獲,也可 能是指"比其他的門徒"。無論如何,主要彼得再次重申,並表明他對主的忠心,並且托付給他重大的任務和使命, 為了重新建立他的自信。如今主也問我們同樣的問題,"你愛我比這更深麼?""這些"可能是我們的事業,家庭, 名譽,地位,嗜好,舒適環境。主愛我們,為我們捨命,並且隨時隨地在我們身邊,我們應當如何回答主,但 主問我們'你愛這些比愛主更深嗎?'



When your will is read . . .

Will people know you were a Christian?

Each year, the Presbyterian Church asks its members to review their estate plans. The obvious reason is to be sure that your plans still reflect your wishes and that your documents are still valid under current laws. Do you need to make any changes due to births, deaths, marriage or divorce? Are your medical directives up to date?

Another reason is to be sure that your estate plans honors the causes and commitments that were important to you in life. Your support for the causes you care deeply about will end with your death, unless you make provisions for that support to continue.

There are many ways to do this. A bequest in your will or trust is one way. There are also investment vehicles which will give you income now, with any remaining principal going to your favorite charity after your death. There are tax-advantaged ways to donate as well.

The Presbyterian Foundation stands ready to help you update your estate plans for make new ones. Our local Development Officer is the Rev. George "Skip" Herbert. He can be reached at 888-233-0060 or <u>geh@fdn.pcusa.org</u>.

In his will, Patrick Henry wrote, "I have now disposed of all my property to my family; there is one thing more I wish I could give them, and that is the Christian religion. If they had this, and I had not given them one shilling, they would be rich; but if they had not that, and I have given them all the world, they would be poor." We can give our faith. Our wills or trusts can be a means of sharing our faith.

當別人讀你的遺囑的時候...

人們會知道你是一個基督徒嗎?

每年長老教會都會請會友重新審查自己的財產計劃。主要的原因是要確認你的 計劃仍舊符合你的理想並且你的文件在現時的法律仍為有效。你是否因為新生兒的誕 生、親人死亡、結婚或離婚,而需要更新你的計劃?你的醫療指標是否都更新了?

此外,檢討你的財產計劃也是對你人生重要的理想及承諾的一個保障。你對你 所在乎的理想之支持將伴隨你的死亡而結束,除非你作出規定支持它繼續。

有很多方法可以延續你的理想。在你的遺囑或信託中遺贈就是一個方法。也有 一些投資的方法還可以為你現在帶來收入,剩下的本金在你過逝後還可以捐贈給你喜 歡的慈善機構。也有以省稅的方式捐贈的。

長老會基金會已經預備好來為你規劃、更新你的財產計劃。我們當地的辦公室 主任是 George "Skip" Hebert 牧師,他的聯絡電話是 888-233-0060 或 geh@fdn.pcusa.org. Patrick Henry 在他的遺囑中寫著:「我現在把我所有的財產留給我的家人; 還有一樣東西我希望也可以給他們,那就是基督教信仰。如果他們有了這個信仰,就 算我沒有留一分錢給他們,他們也是富足的。但是,如果他們沒有這個信仰,就算我 給他們全世界,他們還是貧窮的。」我們可以把我們的信仰留給下一代。我們的遺囑 及信託可以成為一個管道來分享我們的信仰。
